## **PART 1 GENERAL**

#### 1.04 SUBMITTALS

- B. Selection Samples: For each finish product specified, color chips representing manufacturer's full range of available colors and patterns.
- C. Certificate: Submit labels and certificates required by quality assurance and quality control programs.

## 1.05 QUALITY ASSURANCE

- A. Quality Certification:
  - Provide labels or certificates indicating that the installed work complies with AWI/AWMAC/WI (AWS) or AWMAC/WI (NAAWS) requirements for grade or grades specified.
  - 2. Provide designated labels on shop drawings as required by certification program.
  - 3. Provide designated labels on installed products as required by certification program.
  - 4. Submit certifications upon completion of installation that verifies this work is in compliance with specified requirements.

## **PART 2 PRODUCTS**

# 2.01 COUNTERTOPS

- A. Quality Standard: Custom Grade, in accordance with AWI/AWMAC/WI (AWS) or AWMAC/WI (NAAWS), unless noted otherwise.
- B. Plastic Laminate Countertops: High-pressure decorative laminate (HPDL) sheet bonded to substrate.
  - 1. Laminate Sheet: NEMA LD 3, Grade HGS, 0.048 inch (1.2 mm) nominal thickness.
    - a. Manufacturers:

    - b. Finish: Matte or suede, gloss rating of 5 to 20.

- Exposed Edge Treatment: Postformed laminate; front edge substrate built up to minimum 1-1/4 inch (32 mm) thick with raised radiused edge, integral coved backsplash with radiused top edge. REFER TO PLANS for location(s).
- 3. Exposed Edge Treatment: Hardwood nosing as indicated on drawings, natural spar varnish finish; back and end splashes with square top covered with matching laminate.
  - REFER TO PLANS for location(s).
  - b. Wood species to be selected by the Architect from manufacturer's full range of standard wood species Maple.
- 4. Back and End Splashes: Same material, same construction.

## 2.02 MATERIALS

- A. Wood-Based Components:
  - 1. Wood fabricated from old growth timber is not permitted.
- B. Particleboard for Supporting Substrate: ANSI A208.1 Grade 2-M-2, 45 pcf (20 kg/cu m) minimum density; minimum 3/4 inch (19 mm) thick; join lengths using metal splines.
- C. Adhesives: Chemical resistant waterproof adhesive as recommended by manufacturer of materials being joined.
- D. Joint Sealant: Mildew-resistant silicone sealant, white.

## 2.03 ACCESSORIES

A. Fixed Top-Mounted Countertop Support Brackets: Refer to Section 064100.

## 2.04 FABRICATION

- Fabricate tops and splashes in the largest sections practicable, with top surface of joints flush.
  - 1. Join lengths of tops using best method recommended by manufacturer.
  - 2. Fabricate to overhang fronts and ends of cabinets 1 inch (25 mm) except where top butts against cabinet or wall.
  - 3. Prepare all cutouts accurately to size; replace tops having improperly dimensioned or unnecessary cutouts or fixture holes.
- Provide back/end splash wherever counter edge abuts vertical surface unless otherwise indicated.
  - 1. Secure to countertop with concealed fasteners and with contact surfaces set in waterproof glue.
  - 2. Height: 4 inches (102 mm), unless otherwise indicated.

## **PART 3 EXECUTION**

#### 3.01 INSTALLATION

- Securely attach countertops to cabinets using concealed fasteners. Make flat surfaces level; shim where required.
- B. Attach plastic laminate countertops using screws with minimum penetration into substrate board of 5/8 inch (16 mm).
- C. Seal joint between back/end splashes and vertical surfaces.

#### 3.02 CLEANING

A. Clean countertops surfaces thoroughly.

#### 3.03 PROTECTION

- A. Protect installed products until completion of project.
- B. Touch-up, repair or replace damaged products before Date of Substantial Completion.
