Camera Cabling Proposal

Scope of Work

1. SYSTEC101 will furnish and install a total of (140) Cat 6 plenum cables (blue) and (7) Cat 6 outdoor rated riser cables (black) to (147) outlets.

Emmet County (13 Locations):

- 1. We will furnish and install a total of (140) Cat 6 plenum cables (blue) from nearest IDF/MDF room to (140) interior camera outlets.
- 2. We will furnish and install a total of (7) Cat 6 outdoor rated riser cables (blue) from nearest IDF/MDF room to (7) exterior camera outlets.

Common:

- 1. Each interior camera outlet gets (1) Cat 6 jack (blue) on a 2-port surface mount box (white).
- 2. Each exterior camera outlet gets (1) Cat 6 jack (blue) on a 2-port surface mount box (white).
- 3. We will furnish and install a total of (147) Cat 6 patch cords, 3ft (blue) on workstation end.
- 4. All empty ports on faceplates will be covered using blanks.
- 5. We will provide adequate firestop putty and sealant for cable penetration and cable travel.

MDF/IDF buildout (13 Locations):

- 1. We will furnish and install a total of (13) 24-port unshielded modular flat patch panel (black) in existing rack. All new Cat 6 cables will be terminated on these newly installed patch panels.
- 2. No horizontal cable managers will be provided at the IDF/MDF room end.
- 3. We will only furnish and install necessary patch panels and terminations in existing rack. The existing rack should have enough space to install new 24-port modular flat patch panels. If new rack required for any buildout, a new change order will be proposed.

Common:

- 1. We will furnish and install a total of (147) Cat 6 patch cords, 3ft (blue) on IDF/MDF end.
- 2. All patch panels will be provided with a strain relief bar.
- 3. All cabling will be secured using velcro, tie-wraps and other necessary supporting material.

Backbone cabling:

1. No backbone cabling is included in this proposal.

Alternate 1:

Demolition:

1. We will pull and remove all existing aged cables in thirteen locations as required.

Common:

- 1. SYSTEC101 will install, terminate, test and label all the cables provided above.
- 2. All patch panels will be provided with a strain relief bar.
- 3. All labeling will be machine printed.
- 4. All the penetrations made for the installation of telecommunication cables will be firestopped using putty and sealant.
- 5. All terminations and testing will be done as per TIA/EIA/BICSI standards.
- 6. We will provide the Owner with closeouts (test results and as-builts) at the end of the project.

Scope of work by others:

- 1. All 110 VAC, conduit, coring, stub-ups, single device cover, junction boxes, and structural reinforcement.
- 2. Adequate on-site storage will be provided.
- 3. Furnishing and installation of security camera system (device/equipment), TV's, WAP system, access control system, intrusion detection and intercom
- 4. Furnishing and installation of network equipment (switches, SFPs, uplink patch cords and servers) and ISP link (firewall, routers and demarc extension).
- 5. Furnishing and installation of HVAC and electrical systems in the IDF/MDF Room.
- 6. Furnishing and installation of Empty conduits and stub up conduits.
- 7. Furnishing and installation of fire alarm systems.

This warranty shall expire one year after the completion of the project. SYSTEC101 is not responsible for and does not warrant the satisfactory performance of the equipment installed as part of the project excepting for any customization and modification performed by SYSTEC101 and the customer must look solely to any equipment manufacturer warranties in the event of equipment malfunctions or defects. If a malfunction or defect in the project is determined to be equipment related, SYSTEC101 during its one year warrant period will reasonably assist customer is obtaining any warranty coverage provided by equipment manufacturers.

2. Manufacturer's warranty for 25-years will be provided.

Qualifications:

- 1. Due to extreme price fluctuations, we can only hold the material pricing for 60 days. Any material price hikes after 60 days will be borne by the client.
- 2. If required, stub ups, conduits, raceways and coring are to be provided by the customer.
- 3. Pricing does not include any wiremold raceways, power poles, UPS, PDU's or any scope of work related to security, networking equipments.
- 4. SYSTEC101 must have proper access to all areas necessary to complete the project in a timely fashion.
- 5. No cutover, ISP cabling and backbone cabling is included in this proposal.
- 6. Based on General Panduit (Mini-com) cabling solution.
- 7. Any additional labor or material required beyond the scope of this proposal will be done on a change order, signed by a customer representative.
- 8. Conduits, back boxes and pull boxes should be made ready prior to cabling installation.
- 9. Uplinking the entire network using active electronics by others. We will only provide empty network infrastructure, powering the network using network equipment and routers, and connecting them to ISP link is responsible by owner or ISP.
- 10. No backbone cabling (copper and fiber) is included in this proposal.
- 11. No network equipment is included in this proposal. It should be provided by owner or others.
- 12. The Division. 28 is completely excluded from this proposal.
- 13. This proposal includes prevailing wage rate.
- 14. Labor for demolition is included in this proposal.
- 15. Pricing for Scissor lift for (4) separate locations is included in this proposal.
- 16. We will only furnish and install necessary patch panels and terminations in existing rack. The existing rack should have enough space to install new 24-port modular flat patch panels. If new rack required for any buildout, a new change order will be proposed.
- 17. The equipment racks, ladder racks, grounding & bonding, busbars and fire rated plywood backboard at MDF/IDF end to be existing one. If newly required, a new changed order will be proposed.
- 18. We will only provide adequate fire stop putty and sealants for cable penetration and cable travel at both WAO end and IDF/MDF end. If the existing fire stop sleeve at the IDF/MDF end is not sufficient, a new change order will be proposed.
- 19. No conduit and back box will be provided. It should be furnish and installed by the electrical contractor. We will be not responsible for it.
