 - a. Cabling should be installed using ANSI/TIA-568 standards. Restart
- 3. Preference on CAT6 cabling that is used?
 - a. Prefer that cabling is one of the following. We will consider other options. Please note what manufacture you are using.

- 4. Do you want plenum rated cable?
 - a. Yes
- 5. Will work be completed during normal working hours?
 - a. Most of the work will be completed between 7:00 AM and 5:00 PM. Please note the cost for any 2nd shift or weekend work.
- 6. Are there drop ceilings throughout?
 - a. Most of the rooms have drop ceiling.
- 7. Are the promethean boards existing?
 - a. Yes
- 8. Who will be responsible for moving the boards
 - a. If this is something you're able to do, please include it in your quote (section 6 of bid form). Otherwise, Genesee ISD will find another vendor to move the boards.
- 9. Will phase 2 be a complete demo, including walls?
